

## How to Download OverDrive eBooks to Your iPad, iPhone, or iPod Touch

### Lois Wagner Memorial Library

You will need:

- A full privilege, non-Courtesy LWML Library Card
- An Internet connection
- An iPad, iPhone, or iPod touch

#### Download the OverDrive Media Console App

1. Using the Apple App Store, find and download the free OverDrive Media Console app

#### Authorize the OverDrive Media Console App

2. Open the OverDrive Media Console App. You will be prompted to authorize your device with an Adobe ID. If you do not have an Adobe ID, tap register at Adobe.com. After creating an account, reopen the OverDrive Media Console App.
3. Near the upper-right hand corner, tap **Get Books**. At the bottom of the screen, tap **Settings**.
4. In the Adobe Authorization box, tap **Authorize**. Enter your Adobe ID information, and then tap **Authorize**. Near the bottom, tap **Get Books** to return to the **Get Books** screen.

#### Add a Library

5. Tap **Add a Library**. Type in your zip code in the search box and tap Search. Tap **Lois Wagner Memorial Library**.
6. Tap the star next to **Suburban Library Cooperative Media Download Center** to save it as your location for eBooks. Then tap **Suburban Library Cooperative Media Download Center**. This will take you to our site to check out eBooks.

#### Search, Checkout, and Download eBooks


7. Near the upper right, tap **Sign In**. Select **Lois Wagner Memorial Library** from the dropdown menu. Enter your library card number. Tap **Sign In**.
8. Tap the **search icon**, and in the search box enter the title or author you are looking for. Apple devices through the OverDrive Media Console use eBooks in the **EPUB format** and eAudiobooks in the **MP3 format**. Only compatible items with your device will be displayed. Click the title of the book you wish to checkout.

9. To check out your item, click "**Borrow**". The item will be checked out to you.



- If an item is not currently available to be checked out, instead of saying "**Add to Bookbag**" it will say "**Place a Hold**". To put an item on hold, tap the "**Place a Hold**" button. From the **My Digital Holds** screen enter your email address in the boxes where indicated. You will get an email when the item is available to be checked out, and will have 72 hours from when the email is sent to checkout and download your hold.
10. At the Bookshelf screen, click **Download**. For an eBook, choose **EPUB eBook**, and then tap **Confirm & Download**. For an audiobook, choose **MP3 Audiobooks**. The item will be downloaded directly to the OverDrive Media Console app.
11. To open your item, tap **Bookshelf** near the upper-right corner. Tap the cover of the eBook or eAudiobook to open it.
12. To return to the OverDrive Media Console app from within an eBook, tap the center of the screen, and then tap the **back arrow** near the upper-left.

13. To return an item early, tap the **circle/plus icon** then tap **Return/Delete**.



14. To get more items, tap the **Get Books** icon near the upper-right of the **Bookshelf** screen.

### iPad/iPhone/iPod Touch Tips

- To find items that are immediately available for checkout, tap **Search** and then Advanced Search. From the Advanced Search form, select **Adobe EPUB eBook** or **OverDrive MP3 Audiobook** from the **All Formats** dropdown menu. Select "**Show only titles with copies available.**" Click **Search**.
- OverDrive items can be checked out for 7 or 14 days. To change the length of your checkouts, in the OverDrive website tap the **Account** icon then **Settings**.
- The OverDrive Media Console app uses the EPUB format. However, if you have the Amazon Kindle app on your device, you can also use Kindle format eBooks through OverDrive.
