City of Richmond Community Master Plan Public Outreach Meeting

**You are invited to attend the City of Richmond Master Plan
Public Outreach Meeting being hosted by the Planning
Commission on Thursday, November 10, 2016 at 7:00 PM at
Richmond City Hall.**

The Community Master Plan is the guiding document for the future development of the City of Richmond. While a Master Plan typically looks 20 years or more into the future, it must be re-assessed and updated at regular intervals. Richmond's last Master Plan was adopted in 2002. Although the city has been continuously involved in planning (and the Master Plan has been amended), the community's vision for the future has not been comprehensively evaluated for a long time. Your input and ideas are very important in helping to determine what the future of Richmond will look like.

That vision may cover a broad range of topics that are important to quality of life (for example, schools, public safety, etc.); however, the Master Plan focuses primarily on land use, development and infrastructure issues on which city policy can have a direct impact.

Macomb County Staff will be on-hand to help guide us through the visioning process.
