



PARKS

Beebe Street Memorial Park located at 69310 Beebe Street just off 32 Mile Road totals 28.5 acres of developed recreational facilities including: Outdoor community pool; Little League baseball diamonds; 2 enclosed roller hockey courts; 4 basketball courts; children's playground; 2 sand volleyball courts; picnic facilities including a gazebo and picnic pavilion, which may be rented for private use. Last year the City of Richmond received a CMI grant from the Michigan Department of Natural Resources for improvements to Beebe Street Memorial Park. Improvements include new paved roads and parking, one lighted little league ball field, new playground equipment and new restrooms. Bring the family out to Beebe Park this summer and enjoy the great outdoors, and new facilities. City Residents and Non-Residents may reserve the pavilion or gazebo for family reunions, birthday parties, etc. by calling the Recreation Department. Residents may make reservations as early as Jan. 3rd of the current year, and Non-residents may reserve the facilities on or after Feb. 1st of the current year. Indoor restroom facilities are available most of the daylight hours during the summer. The parks also hosts a Hike/Bike Trail which extends 8/10ths of a mile around the perimeter of the park. Winter time facilities include 2 lighted natural outdoor ice rinks. For rental information call or visit the Recreation Office within City Hall.

Bailey Park across the street from Beebe Park, which has available t-ball baseball diamond, a soccer area and tennis courts. Newly upgraded tennis courts will now allow league play within our City. The Historical Society has developed an area of the park which includes a historical school house and railroad depot and a log cabin.

Gierk Street Park located in the south central area of the City is a one acre fenced in facility, which includes a community built playground dedicated to Nicholas Callahan, picnic tables and the Brian Van Meter Memorial bird sanctuary.
