You’ll also find opportunities to volunteer. Take a break from your daily routine and spend a few hours helping out at the library. All age groups are welcome.

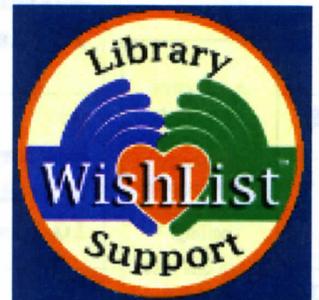
### **People Rely on the Library**
