G Rating = Green Dots **PG Rating = Pink Dots**
PG-13 Rating = Purple Dots and **R Rated items = Red Dots**

Our music CDs also sport multicolored dots:

Popular = Pink Dots **Country = Blue Dots**
Classical = Yellow Dots **Comedy = Purple Dots**
