


They finished their 500 piece puzzle in 1 hour and 7 minutes!

Beginning March 8th, automatic renewals became available through all the libraries in the Suburban Library Cooperative, including ours.


This exciting new service means that outstanding items will automatically renew two days before their initial due date...as long as they are not on hold for another patron.

If you have any questions about the status of your items, please check your account online or call the library via (586)727-2665.


