November 1st.



We hope you are enjoying the new patron catalog,
Vega, where you can place holds, view checkouts
and renew items easily. You will also be able to
make lists and view your checkout history through
the catalog.



NOTE: At the time of migration, all library card
PINs defaulted to the last four digits of each library
card number. Use this number when first logging in
to Vega for the first time; you will then be able to
change it if you'd like.
