- Costumes are not mandatory but encouraged for people working the event.
- Set up is between noon and 5 p.m. You must be set up with all vehicles moved from the parking lot by 5 p.m.
- Be prepared for a minimum of 1000 kids.
- The target age range is 3-12 years of age.
- Each participant will be allotted 1-15x20 space.
- For the safety of the event, there is no smoking and no open flame allowed, other than tea lights to illuminate pumpkins.
- Event will be held rain or shine.
- Each participant is responsible for cleaning up after themselves. No event clean up until after 8 p.m., please.
