The Richmond City Hall, 36725 Division Road, Richmond is temporarily closed beginning the morning of Wednesday, December 2, 2020 through Wednesday, December 9, 2020 in response to the rise in COVID-19 cases and the MDHHS Order.

Police Department Customers:

Phones and email will continue to be answered at the Richmond City Hall. City Hall will make appointments for customers needing in person services such as building, cemetery, planning and zoning.
