- Be prepared for a minimum of 1,000 kids.
- The target age range is 3-12 years of age.
- Each participant will be allotted 1 – 15x20 space.
- For the safety of the event, there is no smoking and no open flame allowed, other than tea lights to illuminate pumpkins.
- Event will be held rain or shine.
- Each participant is responsible for cleaning up after themselves. No event clean up until after 8 p.m., please.
