

2023 GRAND MARSHAL MARK DANIELL



The Grand Marshal of the 2023 Good Old Days Festival is Mark Daniell. Mark has been involved in the community of Richmond for 40 years. He has three daughters and six grandchildren, and worked as a Detroit Public School teacher and Wayne State supervisor of athletics. He also taught driver's education along with Lisa Furton to hundreds of Richmond area teenagers through the Michigan Driving School at St. Peter's Lutheran Church.

Mark was instrumental in starting the Can Am Girl's Softball tournament, and he organized the Voice Summer Classic tennis tournament. Mark spent dozens of years making the "Great Michigan Parade" the parade it is today-the biggest musical parade, with the most marching bands in any parade in the state, and once voted Michigan's Best Small Town Parade by the Detroit News.
