Appointments are encouraged and may be made by calling 586-727-7571 ext 0 from 8:00 am - 4:30 pm. Appointments are in 10 minute blocks.

All protests made through letters must be received in the office **by 4:30 pm on Thursday, March 13, 2014.**

Information on properties in the City is available on the City's website under the Assessor's page or under the "How Do I" link for taxes. You may research all parcels within the City by name or street address.

If you make an appointment with the Board of Review, please be prepared to answer questions as to why you feel you are requesting a reduction in your assessed/taxable value. As the property owner, you are responsible to submit evidence to uphold your claim. Evidence is usually comparable properties but a recent property appraisal may also be submitted. Comparable properties would be by the assessed value, not taxable value. **Three (3)** copies of any evidence you wish to submit must be brought to your appointment. The Board of Review will retain this evidence in their minutes. The Board of Review is unable to return any evidence submitted.

A petition form will be mailed to all those making appointments the week prior to the meetings as a reminder of the day and time that you scheduled. Please fill out this petition form and bring it to your meeting. Petition forms are also available on the Michigan.gov website, form number 4035.

The Board of Review will also hear Poverty Exemption Appeals and Disabled Veterans Exemption Appeals at their meetings in March. Applications are available at the City offices.
