Absentee ballots are available for all elections; registered voters may contact the local clerk to obtain an application for an absent voter ballot.

All electors who are registered in the City of Richmond are eligible to vote at this election. To comply with the Help America Vote Act (HAVA), voting instruction will be available on audio tape and in Braille. Arrangements for obtaining the instructions in these alternative formats can be made by contacting the City Clerk in advance of the election. All polling locations are accessible for voters with disabilities.
