### **FAMILY OPEN SKATING**

All other hours not posted for hockey are reserved for individuals and families ONLY.

1. Hours of permitted use are from dawn to 11 p.m.
2. Rink may be closed for maintenance of ice - follow posted signs.
3. Helmets and appropriate safety equipment are strongly recommended.
4. Users may not add makeshift items, modify or reposition any equipment.
5. Users are responsible for removing their own trash; no littering.
6. No food, beverages or glass containers allowed in the skating area.
7. No alcohol, drugs, smoking, weapons or foul language allowed.
8. Defacing or vandalism will result in full prosecution by law.
9. Please keep noise to a minimum, including music.
10. The City reserves the right to revoke privileges from any individual who does not obey these rules, shows unacceptable conduct or for any other just cause. The City will determine suspensions or permanent banning of individuals, as necessary. A zero tolerance policy is in effect.

By using the facility, users agree to follow all of the posted rules and regulations and understand that failure to follow these rules and regulations will result in being asked to leave the park or will result in Ice Rink closure.
