




You can read many eBooks without downloading an app to your device,


Browsing and Checking Out eBooks and eAudiobooks

1. If you do not have a Kindle Fire, you must use your computer or smartphone to browse for and checkout books. Do not use the experimental browser on the black and white Kindles.
2. In your web browser, go to www.cityofrichmond.net/library and click on **Overdrive e-Books & Audiobooks**.
3. Click on **Sign In** in the upper right hand corner.
4. Select **Lois Wagner Memorial Library** from the drop down menu and enter your complete library card number. Select **Sign In**.
5. Browse for a book by pressing the menu button or search for a specific title or author by pressing the magnifying glass.
3. Titles that are available for check out will have a blue **Available** heading; if a title is not available, it will have a white **Wait List** heading.
4. Check if the book you've found is available to read as a Kindle book by clicking on the cover. If one of the **Formats** on the right hand side says Kindle Book, select **Borrow**. *Not all books are available as Kindle Books at this time.*
5. After selecting **Borrow**, click again when the button says **Go To Loans**.
6. To download the item, click **Download** and select **Kindle Book**.



Transferring From Amazon

1. Amazon.com will open in a new window or tab. When it opens, click on **Get Library Book**.



2. If you are not logged in, you will be prompted to do so.
3. Choose **Deliver** to the appropriate device and select **Continue**.
4. The Kindle Book will be sent to your device the next time it's connected to a wireless network. If it doesn't appear on your device, open the drop down menu on your device and select **Sync**.
 - Library books cannot be delivered via Kindle's 3G connection, they must be delivered either wirelessly or through a USB connection.
 - If your Kindle is not Wi-Fi capable or you do not have an active Wi-Fi connection, see www.amazon.com/kindletransfer for directions to transfer files via USB.

Returning a Kindle eBook early

1. Open Amazon.com in your web browser. Sign in, if you have not already.
2. Click on **Hello, Your Name Accounts & Lists**.
3. Select Manage Your Content and Devices, then select Your Content.
4. Click the box under **Actions**, then select **Return this book** in the window that appears. Click **Yes** to return the eBook.
